**Dinner will be at 6:30 – 7:30 PM.**

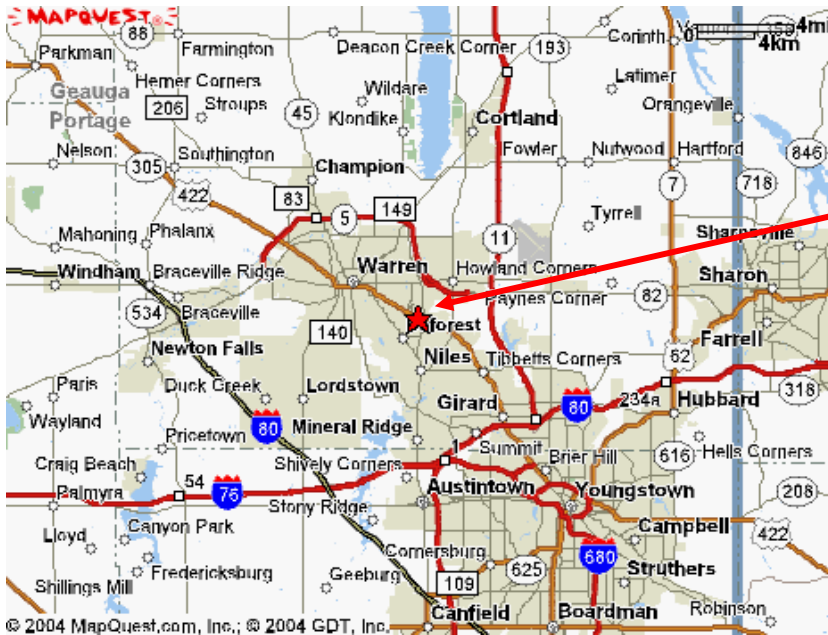
**Presentation at 7:30 PM DMTC by Charles Clark.**

The Defense Metals Technology Center in North Canton, OH was formed in January 2007 to establish an industrial base capable of affordably producing strategic metals. It addresses the identified needs of the U.S. Military in the development and manufacture of vital defense materials, specifically titanium in Northeast Ohio. The DMTC seeks collaborations in Ohio and neighboring states to find innovative and cost savings techniques for making defense materials. Using the combined strengths of the business, metals industry, military, and academic sectors, the DMTC is a direct response to the U.S. Army Armament Research, Development and Engineering Center's call for an industrial base that competitively increases the production of defense materials. The DMTC initiative is operated via federal and state funding.

Mr. Clark has a wealth of experience in the worlds of business and education spanning forty plus years. Educated at Emory, Georgetown, and Northwestern Universities he has worked in the biomedical and financial industries, developed technology at the Batelle Institute and has taught at Kent State University.
